1. The Joy of Knowing God's Love

Romans 5:1-5

1 Peter 1:8

1 John 1:4

Act 2:46

Three Key Truths:

- 1) The **One thing** the world will <u>pay attention</u> to is a church <u>filled with joy</u>: that is how <u>Christianity</u> conquered the ancient world.
- 2) **Nothing** is more <u>important</u> than <u>understanding</u> the <u>power</u> of <u>real joy</u> in <u>Christ</u>, in our own personal lives and living it out.
- 3) <u>Sadly</u> too often our joy is connected to our <u>circumstances</u> and so it goes <u>up</u> and <u>down</u>, <u>not</u> impacting <u>nor</u> influencing people who <u>need</u> Jesus.

2. Two Reasons For Constant Joy (No Matter What)

1) **Joy**: Because God Came To Us

John 1:14

"The Incarnation" - God putting on skin and becoming one of us.

"The Word" - is capitalized because its Jesus Christ, Who came to live among us.

<u>A BIG Joy Robber</u>: thinking our <u>great efforts</u> can <u>earn</u> us a <u>connection</u> <u>with God</u>, when it's <u>God's</u> <u>Loving Grace</u>: <u>God came to us!!</u>

2) <u>God Loves Us Just As We Are</u> And <u>TOO MUCH To Leave Us That Way</u> 1 John 4:9, 16, 17
