Colossians 1:19, 20, 23

1. Paul: Suffering, Serving, Sharing Jesus Christ

Colossians 1:24-27

- 1) Paul's joy in suffering "I am glad when I suffer for you..."
- \Rightarrow Paul's sufferings brought him <u>closer</u> to <u>Christ</u> and were a huge <u>encouragement</u> to <u>others</u>. Acts 9:1-4, 15, 16
- ⇒ When Christ-Followers suffer—Christ also suffers for He Lives in us!
 - 2) Paul serving and sharing "His entire message to you."

Colossians 1:25-29

⇒ Paul was a <u>servant-manager</u> who <u>fully</u> expounded God's revelation which was a "<u>message</u> kept <u>secret</u> for centuries."

Ephesians 3:3-9

Notice: Ephesians 3:6 "Both, Gentiles and Jews share equally in the riches inherited by God's children."

Ephesians 2:12-14

⇒ How Christ loves to fill His Followers with renewed hope!

2. Paul's Purpose and Power

Colossians 1:28, 29

1) Paul's Purpose

"warning" - to admonish, correct, instruct: (Gk) "nouthesia"

"nouthetic counseling" - to lovingly confront people out of a deep concern to help them make changes that God requires

⇒ Paul lovingly confronts not with his own ideas but from God's Word - the Bible.
