Colossians 1:19-23

1. God's Ultimate Purpose: The Reconciling Work of Christ

<u>Reconciliation</u> – "the peace between humanity and God that results from the expiation of sin and the propitiation of God's wrath. "Calvin

Colossians 1:21-23

"Expiation" - removing guilt, the undoing of sin

"Propitiation" - God's holy wrath fully satisfied thru Christ's death on the cross.

<u>Paul "Grinds small"</u> – to ground his readers in the <u>Full Truth</u> of <u>God's revelation</u> so <u>false teachers</u> wouldn't lead them <u>astray</u>.

⇒ Syncretism... Gnosticism... Scientism... Docetism... Statism

Colossians 1:22

"Holy" – Set apart from Sin; "Blameless" – without blemish or defect; "Above Reproach" – Totally without grounds for criticism, "without a single fault."

◆ Paul s not speaking about our personal living out Christ here but about our <u>Position</u> in <u>Christ</u>. 1 John 1:6-10

2. Genuine Christ-Follower Continue to Follow Christ

Colossians 1:23

<u>True Christ-Followers</u>: don't stray away and <u>stay away</u>: Genuine Believers may <u>fall</u> for a while but <u>do</u> return to Christ.

1 Timothy 4:1, 2

1 John 2:1, 4-6, 18, 19

Ephesians 4:14, 15

Hebrews 2:1-3

Colossians 1:23

◆ Earthquakes were a reality around Colossae so Paul's words "not shifting from the hope of the gospel" were a reminder of their security in Christ Alone

3. Paul Rejoices In God's Plan For Him To Suffer

Colossians 1:24

* Paul's sufferings brought him <u>closer to Christ</u> and were also a <u>huge benefit</u> for <u>others to see</u>.

Acts 9:3, 4

* When Christ-Followers suffer Christ also suffers for He dwells in us.

Acts 9:15, 16
