## 1. Getting Real; Getting Right With God

James 4:8, 9

1) Keeping Our Eyes on God As We Cry Out For Mercy

Psalm 130:1

"A song of ascent" - a pilgrim lament song expressing sorrow for sin crying for mercy.

2) "Lament" - "to tell God your <u>deep sorrow</u> for how <u>little you love</u> and <u>serve Him</u> James 4:10

3) "<u>Humble yourself</u>" - to get <u>rid</u> of <u>all hope</u> in <u>myself</u> and instead, <u>accepting</u> what <u>Christ did</u> on the <u>cross</u>: <u>His GRACE</u>, <u>MY NEED</u>

Colossians 3:3

## 2. The BIG DIFFERENCE: <u>Truly Experiencing God</u> Vs. <u>Just Wanting God's Help</u>

Isaiah 6:1-5

\*Isaiah begins to have <u>True</u> / <u>Real</u> / <u>Thorough</u> <u>Repentance</u>

## **Contrast Mark Twain:**

- 1) Sensitive to his own <u>rottenness</u>—but felt <u>sorry</u> for <u>himself</u>—not sorry for his sin against a Holy, <u>Loving</u> God.
- 2) The Result: His confession was Self Pity—leading to a bitter atheism, criticizing God.

Contrast: Isaiah 6:5

<u>TRUTH</u>: When I <u>move closer</u> to God—I see how <u>utterly needy I am</u> and how <u>Great God's love is for me!</u> <u>Isaiah 6:3</u>

\* No more <u>half-hearted praise</u>... No more <u>just saying</u> words... no more <u>hardened</u> heart, <u>ignoring God</u>... <u>Isaiah 6:9</u>

## 3. The FLIPSIDE of Real, Deep Repentance

**NOTICE:** Our Loving God commands us to <u>not</u> just <u>thirst for God</u> but to <u>drink of Christ</u>.
