1. Meeting Their Need For Acceptance

1 Thessalonians 2:7, 8, 11, 12

1) I Accept You

Real Listening Says: "I respect you and I value what you're thinking." James 1:19

2) I Understand You

Three Essentials:

- 1) **Time** not only priority but extended time, not to be a duty but a delight.
- 2) Talk verbally expressing to my child their value to me.
- 3) <u>Talent</u> not trying to impress with our strengths but how we value theirs.

Colossians 1:28, 29

Two Warnings:

- 1) Affection will not be received if they're not convinced of my acceptance.
- 2) If my child hears my <u>affirmation</u> without hearing <u>true acceptance</u> they will feel the need to <u>perform</u> to get my <u>favor</u>.

Reality: Every child runs to those who cheer loudest for them.

2. Meeting Their Need for Affection

1 Corinthians 13:3-7

HUGE: Rules Without Relationship Lead To Rebellion

3. Meeting Their Need For Affirmation

Mark 1:11

CAUTION: "Don't look at me in that tone of eye."

Remember: "Children run to those who cheer for them."

Special Words:

- 1) Praise God for them, in front of them, for special gifts, qualities and passions God gave them.
- 2) Make sure your eyes and words are locking onto them as they do the same to you.
- 3) Give them permission-as they mature-to accept or reject my God: When I give them options-I give them the <u>opportunity</u> to <u>embrace God truly</u>.

4. Children Need Us To Address The Mess

1 Samuel 3:13

- 1) We Are Called To Move Toward The Mess, NOT IGNORING IT
- 2) Make The Deliberate Choice: To See Mess As An Opportunity FOR God's Grace
